

NEMESIS Alfalfa



Alfalfa is the most important forage species in North America, and is considered the "Queen of Forages" because of its high yield and nutritive value.

Alfalfa is well adapted to a wide range of soil and climatic conditions but does best on deep loam soils with a neutral pH.

Alfalfa is sensitive to acidic, water logged soils and will not persist under these conditions

Description

NEMESIS Alfalfa was developed by Cal/West Seeds from elite germplasm sources, selected for multifoliolate expression, high relative feed value (RFV) and disease resistance. The result is a winterhardy, tap-root variety with a very high expression of multiple leaves (90%), an excellent disease package producing large volumes of high quality forage. NEMESIS has a fall dormancy rating of 3, and it has demonstrated winter survival similar to Vernal.

Properly inoculated alfalfa will "fix" nitrogen for the benefit of the host and surrounding plant community.



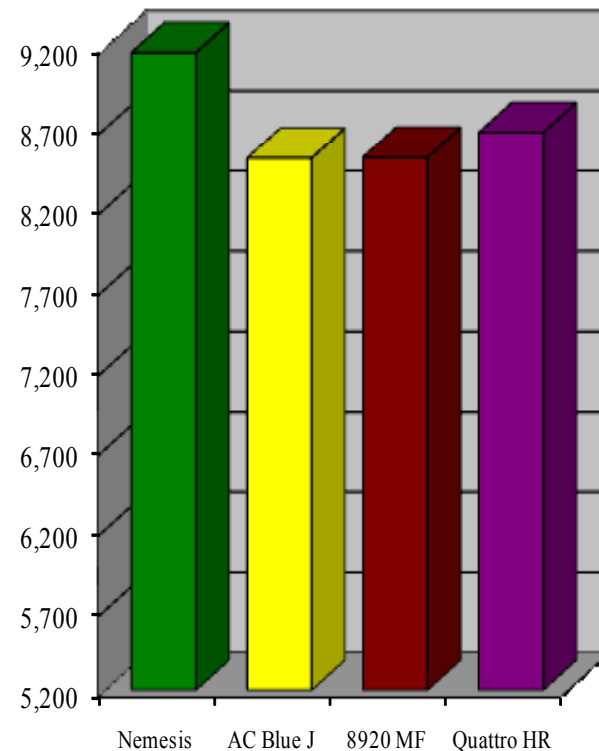
Disease Resistance
